



Passenger Facility Charges

In accordance with legislation adopted by the U.S. Congress, individual airports in the United States may impose a Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) on enplaning passengers. Such PFCs are to be used by the airports to fund FAA-approved airport improvement projects. Once the FAA has approved a PFC, the legislation requires airlines and travel agents to collect PFCs from their passengers.

Airports may impose a PFC of as much as \$4.50 on an enplaning passenger. A listing of PFCs by airport is found at http://www.faa.gov/airports_airtraffic/airports/pfc/monthly_reports (click on “PFC Approved Locations, Collections, and Expiration Dates” and select PDF or MS Excel format).

While CRSs have programmed for PFC collection to automatically apply on computer generated tickets, travel agents will need to know the PFC application for manually prepared tickets, exchanges and refunds.

General Questions and Answers

What is a PFC?

The U.S. Congress has enacted a law that permits airports to impose a fee of \$1.00, \$2.00, \$3.00, \$4.00, or \$4.50 on enplaning passengers. Such fees are to be used by the airports to fund FAA-approved airport improvement projects. The legislation requires the air carriers and their agents to collect such fees. Air carriers may be subject to financial penalties for non-compliance.

From whom are PFCs collected?

A PFC generally will be imposed on all revenue passengers enplaned at an airport authorized to collect PFCs. Nonrevenue passengers from whom no PFC may be collected include air carrier employees or others receiving transportation against whom token service charges are levied, as well as infants for whom a token fare is charged.

A PFC will not be collected from a passenger in the following circumstances:

- If the passenger obtained the ticket with a frequent flyer award coupon without monetary payment.

This exception applies to any zero-fare award of air transportation by a carrier to a passenger in exchange for accumulated travel mileage credits in a customer loyalty program, whether or not the term “frequent flyer” is used to define that program. The “frequent flyer” award exception does not apply to redemption of credits for additional or upgraded service on trips for which the passenger has paid a published fare, two-for-the-price-of-one or similar marketing programs, or air transportation purchased for a passenger by other persons.

- On flights, including flight segments, between 2 or more points in Hawaii.
- On enplanements in Alaska aboard an aircraft having a certificated seating capacity of less than 60 passengers.
- If the passenger did not pay for the air transportation due to charter arrangements and payments by the Department of Defense.

Certain other classes or categories of air transportation may also be exempt under the terms of the PFC in effect for a particular airport.

How will these Charges be collected?

The charges are collected by the airlines and travel agents at the time of ticket issuance based on the itinerary at the time of issuance. Agents remit the charges through ARC along with other fees and taxes, and the airlines distribute the funds to the appropriate airports.

When are PFCs to be collected?

Any ticket issued on or after the effective date of a PFC must reflect the specific PFC and its related airport. The PFC is assessed for a departure from an airport, not arrival.



How many PFCs can be collected on One Ticket?

No more than two PFCs can be imposed on any one-way ticket and no more than four on any round trip. If a one-way trip involves more than two airports that have PFCs, the charges are limited to the first two PFC-approved airports in the itinerary. For a round trip with multiple segments, PFCs are collected for the first two and the last two PFC-approved airports (excluding the destination city because PFCs are only collected on enplanement cities).

Definition of a Round Trip:

A Round Trip is a trip on a complete air travel itinerary that terminates at the origin point.

Definition of a Point:

The FAA advises that a point generally is the airport at which travel begins or ends. Where a locality is serviced by more than one airport, the point is determined by referencing the current version of the Official Airline Guide. For defining a round trip for purposes of calculating applicable PFCs, a trip can begin and end at co-terminal airports. E.g., San Francisco International (SFO) and Metropolitan Oakland International (OAK). Note: A listing of multiple/co-terminal airports is provided on page 4 of this section.

How Are PFCs to be Reflected on the Ticket?

Each PFC paid by the passenger and the airport for which it is collected are to be shown on the ticket. The sum of all the PFCs collected is shown in the tax box using the code “XF” and is included in the total amount paid. PFC details are shown in the Fare Calculation area. For example: “XFLAS4” means a PFC was collected for an enplaning passenger at Las Vegas, NV, for \$4.00.

Are PFCs Collected for Air Transportation between Two Airports Listed as Being Co-Terminals?

A PFC will be collected if the passenger is departing a PFC airport and flying to a different airport (by airplane or helicopter) even though both airports are listed as co-terminal points.

Are PFCs to be collected on PTAs?

Yes, with the date of issue of the PTA determining whether a specific PFC applies. For a PTA written in the U.S. for a ticket to be issued outside the U.S. for travel commencing outside the U.S., contact the PTA Desk to determine the carrier’s policy on collecting PFCs.

If all Tickets issued in the U.S. are to include Applicable PFCs, What is considered the U.S.?

The U.S. is defined as the fifty states, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, American Samoa, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, and Guam.

Are there any Airport Exceptions to PFC Collection?

A PFC is not to be collected from a passenger for an enplanement on any flight to an eligible point on an air carrier that receives compensation under the Essential Air Service (EAS) program on that route, e.g., air service provided by Great Lakes Aviation from Denver to Pueblo, CO. The FAA advises that an “eligible point” is an airport that is guaranteed air service on an EAS-designated route. Each time a new PFC is announced, ARC agents will be informed of any special limitation for EAS flights.



What happens when a Ticket is exchanged?

Any changes in itinerary that are initiated by the passenger that require an adjustment of the amount paid by the passenger are subject to collection or refund of the PFC as appropriate.

Details and examples are provided in the Refund Exchange Section of this Handbook.

Are PFCs Refundable?

The general rule is that anytime a ticket is refunded, so are the PFCs. When the ticket is not refunded, neither are the PFCs. Details and examples are provided in the Refund Exchange Section of this Handbook.

Where do I Show PFCs on a Manual Ticket?

When a PFC is collected, the airport to which the PFC applies, and the amount indicator reflecting the dollar amount collected (1=USD 1.00 2=USD 2.00 3=USD 3.00 4=USD 4.00 4.5=USD 4.50) must be shown at the end of the Fare Calculation ladder on the ticket.

When the last fare entry has been completed in the fare calculation ladder, draw a single heavy line underneath. This will now be the area where the PFCs are to be indicated. Enter the PFC indicator code of "XF" under the column titled **FROM/TO**. Leave the column titled **CARRIER**, blank. In the column titled **FARE CALCULATION**, enter in itinerary order, the airport code, followed by the PFC amount indicator. This entry is mandatory.

Where Do I Show PFCs on a Prepaid Ticket Advice?

When a PFC is collected, the airport to which the PFC applies and the amount indicator reflecting the dollar amount collected (i.e., 3=USD 3.00) must be shown in the lower, right hand corner of the "Routing/Fare Basis/Reservation Data" box. For each PFC collected, enter in itinerary order, the airport code followed by the PFC amount indicator.

The total amount of all PFCs collected is entered in the "OTHER TAX" box preceded by the PFC code of XF.
